## Local Service Wire Policy

Chazy and Westport Communications (C\&W) will provide 500 feet of fiber / copper at no cost. Beyond 500 feet the customer will pay an additional fee for the fiber/copper.

C\&W's preferred method of deployment is aerial. Overhead cable is usually placed onjointly used power poles and deployed at no cost. If a customer requires underground services the following specifications must be met with any cost associated being covered by the customer:

1. Meet with a representative from CW to confirm placement of conduit
2. Conduit must be placed in all cases and a minimum of 6 inches below ground.
3. Conduit must be a minimum of 1 inch inside diameter.
4. Conduit must have a pull line (not mason string) installed and the exposed ends covered.
5. Conduit must be brought up on the outside ofthe house/building and be exposed on both ends. (please temporarily cover with a bag or tin can)
6. Conduit can be placed in the same trench as the power conduit as long as a 24 -inch minimum depth is achieved.
7. C\&W will inspect conduit installs, prior to backfill to insure proper installation. An improper conduit install will delay your service hook-up.
