

## Local Service Wire Policy

Chazy and Westport Communications (C&W) will provide 500 feet of fiber / copper at no cost. Beyond 500 feet the customer will pay an additional fee for the fiber/copper.


C&W's preferred method of deployment is aerial. Overhead cable is usually placed on jointly used power poles and deployed at no cost. If a customer requires underground services the following specifications must be met with any cost associated being covered by the customer:

- 1. Meet with a representative from CW to confirm placement of conduit
- 2. Conduit must be placed in all cases and a minimum of 6 inches below ground.
- 3. Conduit must be a minimum of 1 inch inside diameter.
- 4. Conduit must have a pull line (not mason string) installed and the exposed ends covered.
- 5. Conduit must be brought up on the outside of the house/building and be exposed on both ends. (please temporarily cover with a bag or tin can)
- 6. Conduit can be placed in the same trench as the power conduit as long as a 24-inch minimum depth is achieved.
- 7. C&W will inspect conduit installs, <u>prior to backfill</u> to insure proper installation. An improper conduit install will delay your service hook-up.

- 1. ONT Mounts Inside the house. AC power needed.
- 2. Conduit in the house approx 4 ft. above final grade.
- 3. Conduit in pedestal-1ft above ground.
- 4. Conduit at mobile home—4ft above ground on the outside of skirting.

- 1. ONT mounts inside house. AC power needed.
- 2. Conduit in the house Approx 4 ft. above final grade.
- 3. Conduit at the pole—4ft above ground "tight to the pole"
- 4. Conduit at raobile horae 4ft above ground on the outside of skirting
